ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL

IN ORDER TO VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL, A VOTER MUST MEET CERTAIN LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS. A VOTER DESIRING TO VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL, SHALL IN WRITING OVER HIS SIGNATURE EITHER IN PERSON AT THE ELECTION COMMISSION OFFICE OR BY MAIL, REQUEST AN APPLICATION FOR AN ABSENTEE BALLOT. SUCH REQUEST FOR AN APPLICATION MAY BE RECEIVED NO EARLIER THAN THE 90TH DAY PRIOR TO THE ELECTION, AND MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 30, 2018. THE REQUEST CAN SERVE AS AN APPLICATION FOR BALLOT IF IT CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING: NAME, ADDRESS OF RESIDENCE, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DATE OF BIRTH, ADDRESS TO MAIL THE BALLOT TO, THE ELECTION/S THE VOTER WISHES TO VOTE IN INCLUDING PRIMARY IF APPLICABLE, THE REASON THE VOTER WISHES TO VOTE ABSENTEE, AND THE VOTER'S SIGNATURE.

- 11) PERSONS WITH VALID COMMERICAL DRIVERS LICENSE THAT WILL BE OUT OF THE COUNTY OR STATE DURING EARLY VOTE AND ELECTION DAY
