

RESOLUTION NO. 19-5

TO PROVIDE FOR EDUCATION INCENTIVE PAYMENTS TO FULL-TIME ELECTED OFFICIALS OF BEDFORD COUNTY GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, under T.C.A. 5-1-310(i), counties are authorized and encouraged to provide in the annual budget for payment of an educational incentive to full-time elected county officials who attain the designation of "Certified Public Administrator" under the University of Tennessee County Technical Assistance Service's County Officials Certificate Training Program (COCTP); and

WHEREAS, Bedford County desires to provide for such an incentive payment in its budget for the fiscal year 2018-19;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Bedford County, Tennessee, assembled in regular meeting on the 12th day of June, 2018, that:

SECTION 1. Any full-time elected county official and the Clerk and Master of Bedford County who has completed the COCTP and attained the designation of Certified Public Administrator and who submits to the county mayor proof of such attainment on or before October 1, 2018, shall be paid in an amount not to exceed the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) less any payment received from the State of Tennessee as provided in subsection (a). The incentive provided by this section shall be paid in one (1) payment, no later than October 31, 2018, from county funds appropriated for that purpose for the fiscal year 2018-19.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval, the public welfare requiring it.
