

ADA Transition Plan Public Meeting Notice

Bedford County is hosting a public meeting for the ADA Facilities Self Evaluation and Transition Plan.

Bedford County is currently preparing an Americans with Disability Act (ADA) Transition Plan.

The transition plan requires public entities to evaluate its current services, policies and practices to ensure persons with disabilities are protected from discrimination on the basis of a disability.

About the Transition Plan

The transition plan has been completed in various phases, with the self-evaluation phase consisting of the inventory of the County's facilities such as buildings and parks. Other Right-of-Way (ROW) features evaluated consisted of curb ramps, sidewalks, and obstructions within sidewalks and ramps and parking lots.
